**Nehiyaw (Cree) educator Reuben Quinn of the Centre for Race and Culture** will teach key principles and concepts as he introduces the Nehiyaw writing system called *nehiyaw atahkipeyihkanah*. Participants must commit to attending all classes.

The Nehiyaw language lessons being offered by the Centre for Race and Culture use **a unique methodology** called *atahkipehikanak* (spirit markers), which is better known as the star chart/syllabics. This traditional format incorporates the cultural and spiritual teachings of the Nehiyaw language.

**This method of teaching the Nehiyaw (Cree) language** is not used anywhere in the greater Edmonton area or in the entire educational system in Edmonton.
