Nehiyaw (Cree) educator Reuben Quinn of the Centre for Race and Culture will teach key principles and concepts as he introduces the Nehiyaw writing system called *nehiyaw atahkipeyihkanah*. Participants must commit to attending all classes.

The Nehiyaw language lessons being offered by the Centre for Race and Culture use **a unique methodology** called *atahkipehikanak* (spirit markers), which is better known as the star chart/syllabics. This traditional format incorporates the cultural and spiritual teachings of the Nehiyaw language.

This method of teaching the Nehiyaw (Cree) language is not used anywhere in the greater Edmonton area or in the entire educational system in Edmonton.
