Nehiyaw (Cree) educator Reuben Quinn of the Centre for Race and Culture will teach key principles and concepts as he introduces nehiyaw writing system called nehiyaw atahkipeyîhkanah. Participants must commit to attending all classes.

The lessons being offered use a unique methodology called atahkipehikanak (spirit markers), which is better known as the star chart (or syllabics), a traditional format that incorporates the cultural and spiritual teachings of the nehiyaw language.

This method of teaching nehiyaw (cree) language is not used anywhere in the greater Edmonton area or in the entire educational system in Edmonton.
